READ LUKE 5:10

DAY


READ PROVERBS 16:9

Go get two different colored pens. Take a look at the maze below. Make a plan for how you will get through it. Take as long as you need. Now close your eyes and try to solve it without peeking.

Now, get somone to help you. While you close your eyes, using a different pen, ask that person to guide your hand through the maze. Open your eyes. How did you do this time? Hopefully much better, since you had someone guiding your way!

Even when do our best to make plans for the future and make wise decisions about which path to take, ultimately we need help. Good thing God is in control of our direction, because if we did it on our own, we'd probably make a mess of things!
